



Explanation of IHAA sanctioned competitions

Thank you for considering applying to have your event sanctioned by the IHAA as “Record & Ranking” or “Accredited”. We hope that the information below will explain the differences and make the application process clear.

- ❑ **Date** : future event (status cannot be awarded retrospectively)
- ❑ **Rules**: IHAA general & competition rules [link: [PDF](#), [online viewer](#)]
- ❑ **Scoring**: must use the ihaa.eu scoring portal
- ❑ **Horse use**: IHAA Code of Equine welfare must be followed [link]

- ❑ **Remote entries**

To ensure full compliance with IHAA rules only in-person events can be sanctioned

- ❑ **Events:**

- All / most are IHAA standard tracks

World Ranking tracks = HBAE Raid, Tower & Hunt track

Record tracks = HBAE Raid, Tower, Tabla4 & Skirmish

- Local / culturally important non-standard tracks permitted

Any of:

- IHAA standard tracks

- Local/cultural non-standard tracks

- Tracks using rules for kids

- Testing during rule development

- ❑ **NB:** IHAA standard tracks must be run according to the IHAA rulebook

- ❑ Does your event include WFEA Kassai track (instead of Tower) / WHAF Korean (instead of Raid) ?

Apply to your national association, usually via a form or email. State what level you wish to apply for.

Eligible for IHAA Record & Ranking



Rep / National Competition Liaison Officer must **apply** to the IHAA, at least 10 days before the event. Application fee payable by organiser (2* = E20, 3* = E40, 4* = E80)

Eligible for IHAA ACCREDITED



Rep / National Competition Liaison Officer can authorise if all of the conditions are met. No fee.

- ❑ **Benefits:**

- All results on ranking tracks count for World Ranking. World Records can be broken

- Results can be used for IHAA Grading “competition scores”
